DIRECTIONS

This computer program is for use with only the COMMODORE 64 HOME COMPUTER. Follow the directions in your Cassette Unit Operating Instructions manual for connecting the COMMODORE cassette recorder to the connector at the rear of the computer.

OPERATION

1. Turn on the computer.

2. Insert Computer Program Cassette into cassette recorder (label up) and rewind the tape if necessary then press STOP on recorder.

3. When READY appears with a flashing square (), type the word LOAD then touch return key.

NOTE

- 4. Be sure that READY appears in upper case letters. If not, simultaneously touch the COMMODORE KEY & SHIFT KEY. Then make certain that the SHIFT LOCK key is in the up position.
- When PRESS PLAY ON TAPE appears press the PLAY button on the cassette player; screen will go blank.
- 6. From this point loading the program will be done automatically by the COMMODORE 64 HOME COMPUTER. Typically, it takes 2 - 5 minutes to load most programs - so be patient.
- 7. LOADING and READY with the flashing square will appear after 2 5 minutes to announce program has been successfully loaded into the computer.
- 8. On the cassette recorder, press the STOP button followed by the REWIND button to rewind the Computer Program Cassette back to the beginning of the tape. After tape stops moving, press the STOP button.
- 9. Return the Computer Program Cassette back into its' protective box for safety.
- 10. You are now ready to start the program. Type RUN then press the RETURN key. Program will start automatically and instructions for use will be displayed.
- 11. If you experience difficulty in loading the program, refer to the "Getting Started" section of your COMMODORE 64 USER'S GUIDE and also the Operating Instructions manual of the cassette unit.
